Lieutenant Commander George Marvin Lloyd was born on July 27, 1934, in Walla Walla, Washington. He graduated from Whitman College in June 1957 with an AB in chemistry. Upon graduation from Officers Candidate School in Newport, Rhode Island in October, he was commissioned as Ensign, USNR. His first duty station was Headquarters, Field Command Defense, Atomic Support Agency, Sandia Base in Albuquerque, New Mexico. There he acted as Chief, Visitor Control Branch, in the Office of the Security Officer.

During a brief separation from the Navy, Commander Lloyd was selfemployed from 1960 to 1961.

Rejoining the Navy in 1961, Commander Lloyd served aboard USS MIDWAY (CVA 41) as First Division Officer and Fox Division Officer. After two years, he was transferred to USS VESUVIUS (AE 15) where he served as Operations Officer. Completing two years aboard the VESUVIUS, Commander Lloyd attended the Defense Language Institute, West Coast Branch, at Presidio, California where he studied Spanish. In 1966, Commander Lloyd reported to the National Security Agency, Fort George G. Meade, Maryland, where he served for over two years. Prior to his arrival to the ASHTABULA, Commander Lloyd was a student at the National Cryptological School at the National Security Agency.

Having operated with the "Old ASHTABULA", Commander Lloyd was pleased as well as surprised with the new "FLYING A". Commander Lloyd is a member of the Alpha Zeta Honorary Society, Elliot Chapter, and the Mason Lodge.
