

# Captain(Sel) David P. Maloney

## Executive Officer

Commander Dave “Moses” Maloney, the son of Joseph and Muriel Maloney, was born in Bristol, Pennsylvania. He grew up in Pittsburgh Pennsylvania and went on to earn his Bachelor of Science Degree in Economics from Saint Bonaventure University in New York. He graduated from Aviation Officer Candidate School and was commissioned in May of 1983. He completed flight school and earned his Aviator Wings in August 1984.

Following completion of Fleet Replacement Pilot training, his first Junior Officer tour was in Helicopter Squadron Two (HS-2), where he served as Public Affairs Officer, Aircraft Division Officer, and NATOPS Officer. This was followed by a second sea tour this time with HS-4, where he served as Assistant Operations Officer and Tactics Officer. For his Department Head tour he returned once again to HS-2, where he served as both the Safety Officer and Maintenance Officer. Now in line for Command at sea, he was assigned to HS-6 as the Executive Officer and then assumed the reigns as Commanding Officer. Commander Maloney’s career has seen him deployed to the Western Pacific Ocean, Indian Ocean, and Arabian Gulf aboard the aircraft carriers USS KITTY HAWK (CV 63), USS CONSTELLATION (CV 64), USS NIMITZ (CV 68) and USS CARL VINSON (CVN 70).

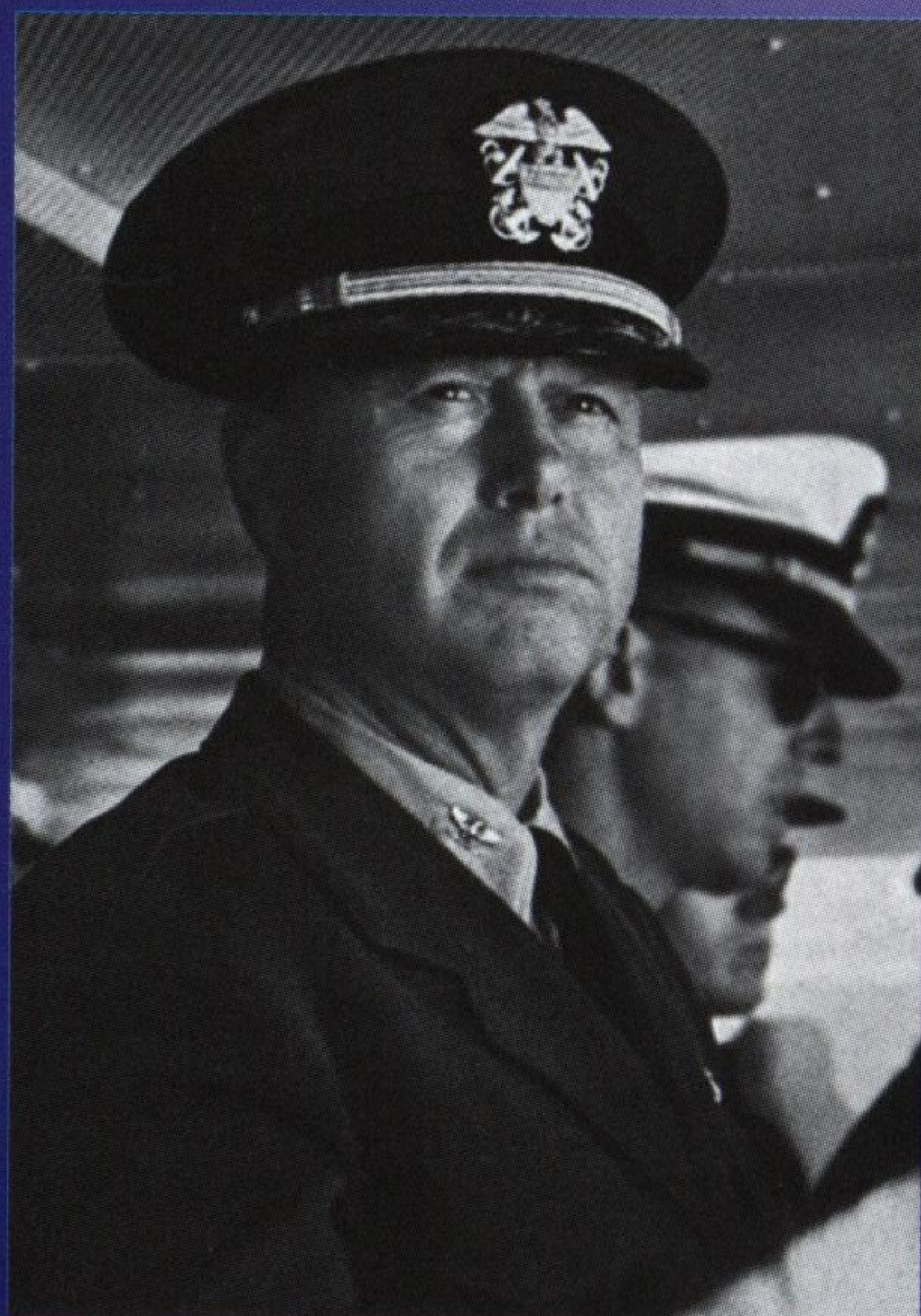


His shore duty assignments were as a Fleet Replacement Squadron flight instructor at both HSL-41 and HS-10, and as the Helicopter Junior Officer Detailer and Shore Coordinator at the Bureau of Naval Personnel, in Washington DC. In 1993, he earned a Master of Arts Degree in National Security and Strategic Studies from the Naval War College in Newport, RI.

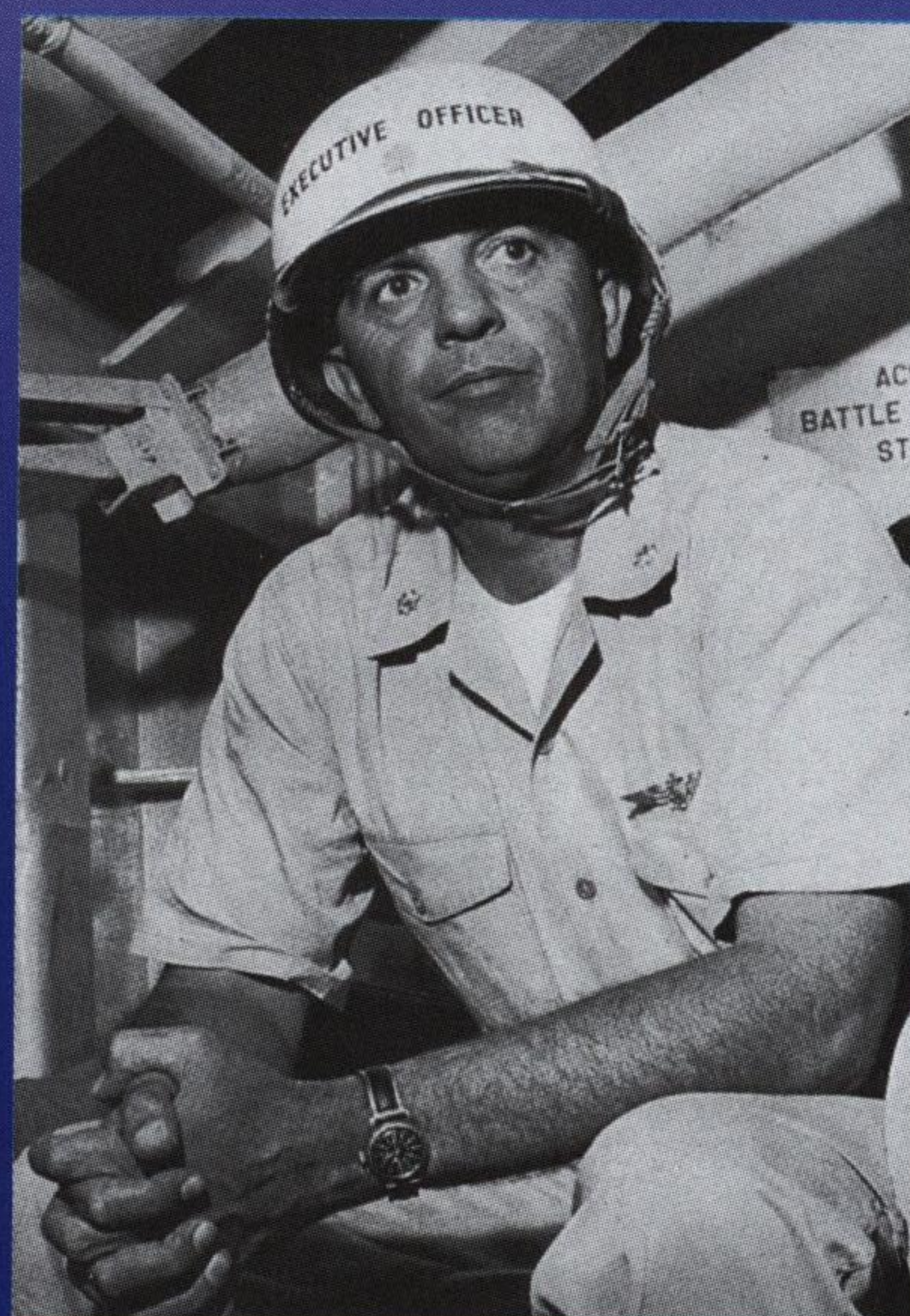
