Aircraft Intermediate Maintenance Department (AIMD): This highly industrialized department of state of the art skilled technicians provides full spectrum on/off aircraft avionics, structural, power plants, hydraulics and life support systems maintenance as well as complete ground support. Comprised of four divisions with an at sea manpower strength of 450 personnel, manning 28 diverse work centers and stressing productivity and quality.

IM-1 is the Administrative Support Division within AIMD and is comprised of Production Control, Quality Assurance and Administration. IM-2 (General Maintenance) consist of the Powerplants Shop, Airframes, Hydraulics and the Survival Equipment Shop. IM-3 has 60% of all assigned AIMD manpower and is comprised of the PME (Precision Measuring Equipment) Work Center, Avionics, Electrical, Ordnance and Aviation Nickel-Cadmium Battery Shops. IM-4 is made up of the Aviation Support Equipment technicians who maintain the "Yellow Gear" for the entire ship. Broken into three rates maintaining the Electrical, Mechanical and Hydraulics Systems, these 50 men maintain over 380 pieces of diverse equipment.
